Call for applications for short-term student mobility within the Erasmus+ program, "Intensive Mixed Mobility Programs", at the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II, during the winter semester of the Academic Year 2024 – 2025, in the Blended Intensive Program (BIP) entitled "Human Centered AI – Education and Research in Practice (HCAI-ERP)"

The University of West Attica and the MSc "Artificial Intelligence and Deep Learning" (AIDL), in the context of the Erasmus+ Program KA 131, Blended Intensive Programs (BIPs) - Mobility of Students for Studies - Short-term Mobility, enable up to 6 students of the MSc "Artificial Intelligence and Deep Learning", to participate in the Blended Intensive Program (BIP) entitled "Human Centered AI - Education and Research in Practice (HCAI-ERP)" organized by the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II, in Naples Italy.

The total duration of the program is approximately two weeks, distributed as follows: (a) one week of live teaching at the premises of the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II from 02 to 06 December 2024, and (b) approximately a week of online teaching (ie, without physical presence) through participation in virtual activities that will be organized at a different time by the Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II. Students who will successfully participate in the BIP will receive a total of 3 ECTS in the Diploma Supplement of the MSc.

Financial aid (scholarship) from the Erasmus+ program is provided for the students' movement for all participating students. Students will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Students must have completed 1 semester of studies at MSc "Artificial Intelligence and Deep Learning", and have successfully passed at least 50% of the courses they have attended. (Severity: subject to disqualification.) Evidence: Score certificate from the Secretariat of the MSc
- 2. Knowledge of English, at least at B2 level (Weight: 30%). Marking 10 % for level B2, 20 % for level C1 and 30 % for level C2. Evidence: certificate of knowledge of the English language recognized by the state.

For students who do not have a certificate of English language proficiency, the corresponding score is 10% if proficiency in the English language has been certified during their enrollment through an examination in a manner decided by the S.E. of MSc or they are graduates of English-speaking universities.

- 3. Percentage of courses in which they have been successfully examined calculated on the number of courses they have attended (Weight: 40 %). Evidence: Score certificate from the Secretariat of the MSc.
- 4. Student's application and letter about his/her motivations for moving through the action in question (Weight: 30%). A standard application and letter is attached as an appendix to this Notice. Supporting documents: Application form and letter drawn up and signed by the student concerned and a short CV in Euro-pass format.
